

Call for Student Research Poster Presentations in the Field of Autism Spectrum Disorders

Proposal Requirements:

The purpose of the student research poster presentation session is to provide students with a forum to present their current research. This format is appropriate for completed research as well as works in progress. The poster session is designed to foster interaction with the audience of professionals and other autism researchers.

- a) Title of Poster: limit to 12 words (max 200 characters)

- b) Type of Research: select most applicable
 - Intervention (e.g., school age, adult, early intervention)
 - Medical and/or Pharmacological
 - Descriptive (e.g., adult outcomes)
 - Animal Models

- c) Presenter information: The following information is required for the proposer and co-presenter(s)
 - Name
 - Primary presenter must be a current student associated with an academic institution (undergraduate, graduate, doctoral, post-doctoral, intern)
 - Position and Credentials
 - School/Organization
 - Permanent Mailing Address
 - Telephone number
 - Email Address
 - Submit the Curriculum Vitae (CV) of the primary student presenter

- d) Description of Proposal:
Maximum of 500 words (references count towards this limit). Provide a detailed description of your proposal, organized in terms of the following sections.
 - Purpose/objectives of the research
 - Methods (e.g., participants, research methodology, measures, description of study)
 - Results
 - Implications for the field
